WHAT ARE CUSTOM-MADE ORTHOTICS?

Orthotics are designed to correct the alignment of the foot and ankle. They are placed in shoes to improve foot pain and walking patterns. Each pair is made directly from a 3D laser scan of your foot. They allow for better pressure distribution to reduce and prevent foot pain and complications.
